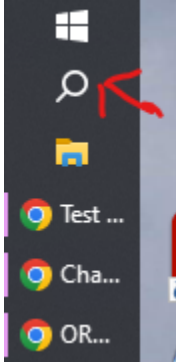


Enabling .NET 3.5 on Windows 10/11

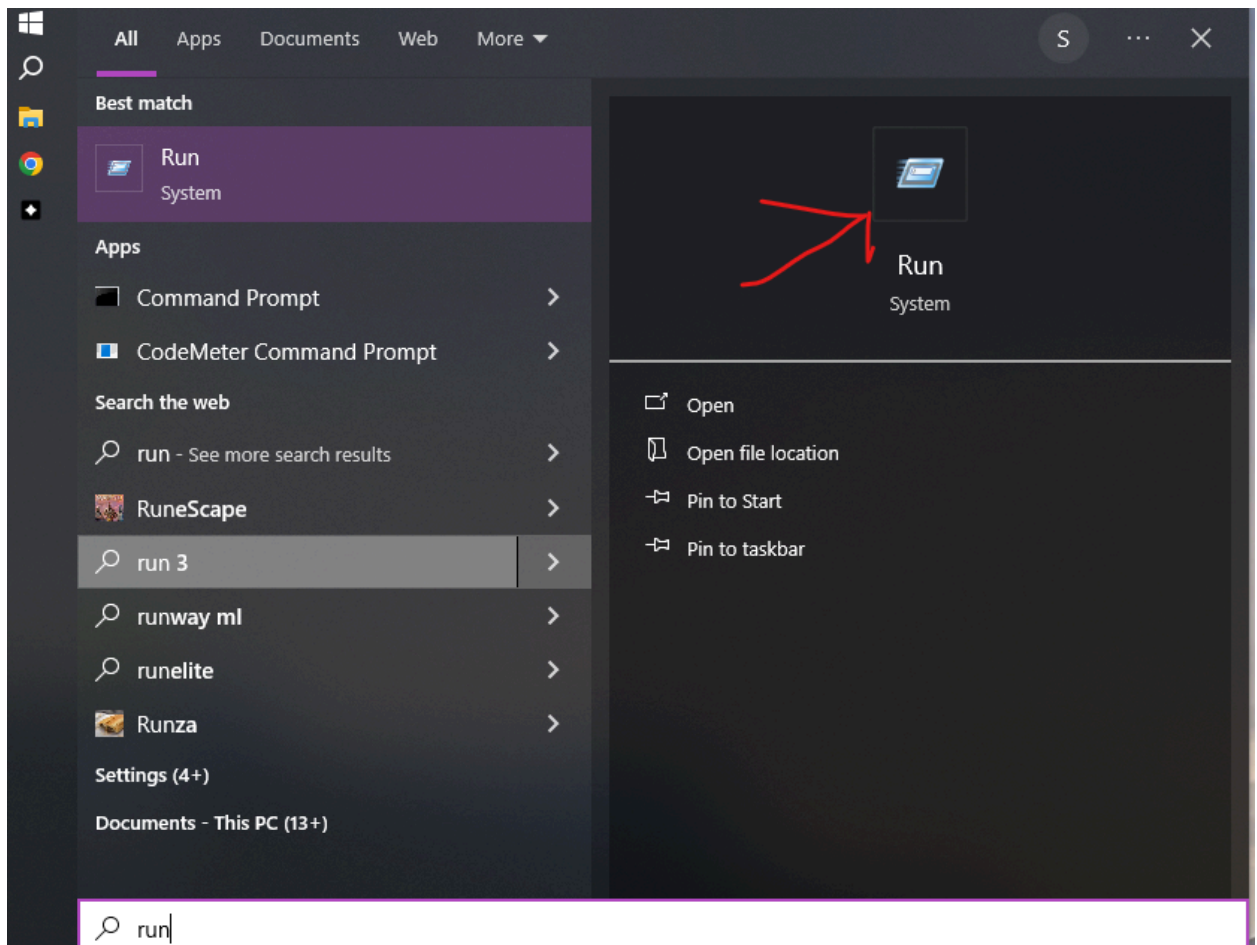
1. Go to your windows search. On my screen, it is next to the start menu.



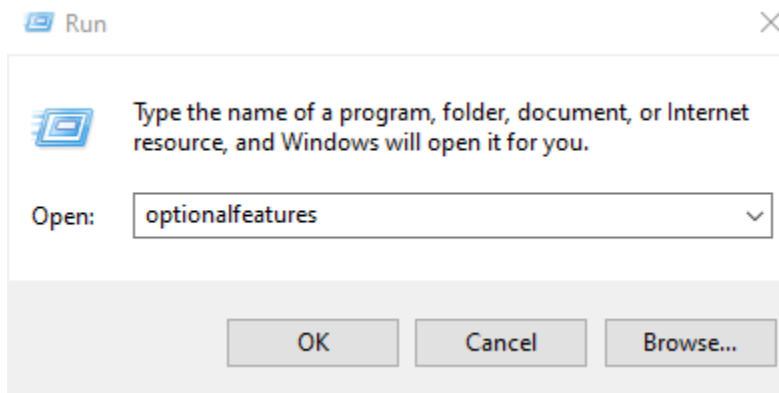
You can also open the start menu and start typing to search.

2. Search "Run"

You should see the Run application

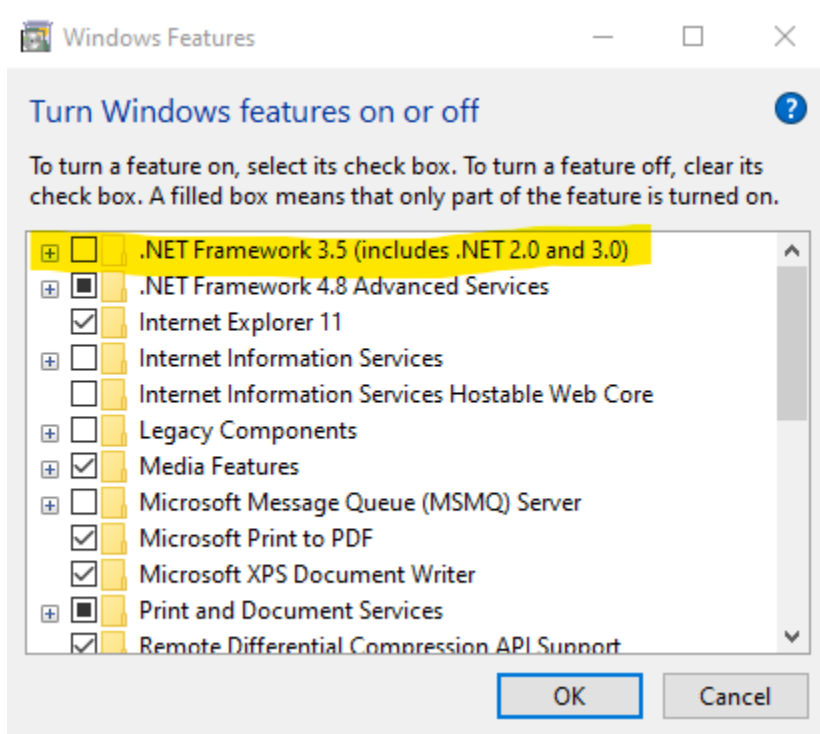


3. Open the Run application and type "optionalfeatures"

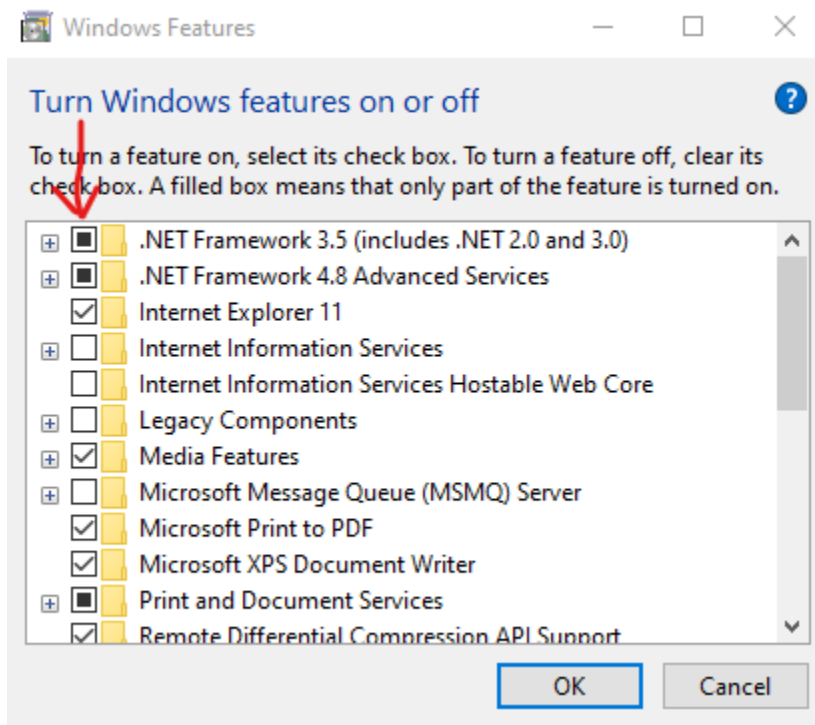


Hit OK

4. The Windows Features application should open. There should be a line for .NET Framework 3.5.



5. Click the box and make sure it has a dark square.



Click OK.

.NET 3.5 is now enabled.
